

Nomination of Faculty Member for Teaching Award

Innovation – diversity – passion: These FAU core values should find expression in good teaching. That is why we kindly ask you to outline to what extent the nominated person fulfils the following criteria. Whilst this would ideally be the case when the nomination is submitted by students or other faculty members, we would ask you to make sure that it is included when the nominations are forwarded to the VP-E at the latest. The questions are only an orientation aid and it is not necessary to work through all of them. They are supposed to give you impulses as to the possible ways in which the nominated faculty member might be an outstanding teacher. Therefore, please feel free to nominate faculty members even if they do not fulfil all criteria to the same extent. We encourage you to nominate women as well. Please specifically consider whether you know excellent female teachers you would like to nominate.

1. Teaching concept and quality

1.1 Role and person

Does the faculty member show interest in the students' learning process? Does he/she show enthusiasm for the topic? Are there any other outstanding aspects (e.g. behaviour, rhetoric, liveliness)?



1.2 Quality aspects of good teaching

Are there any examples for the continuous and successful initiation of student activities? Does the faculty member encourage self-study and individual responsibility? Does he/she express expectations and learning objectives clearly? Does he/she give feedback, learning aids, and/or support when difficulties arise? Is there a transparent connection between the contents of the course and research? Does he/she pay attention to interdisciplinary aspects? Does he/she give examples for application or provide authentic learning situations? Does he/she illustrate the connections between theories and research methods on the one side and life and professional practice on the other?
